### **Year 11 Mock Report**

Your child will be bringing home their mock exam report Monday 18th December 2023. We hope that the format will enable you to see what progress your son/daughter is making in their GCSE courses.

The report will give the grade that your son/daughter's teachers have given as a result of the recent mock examinations they have taken in school. There is also an effort grade noting how well each teacher feels your child has prepared for and undertaken the mock exams they took. Score of 1 means attempted all questions to the best of their ability; 2 means attempted mostly lower tariff questions/areas and did not answer the higher tariff questions/areas as well; 3 means very little effort made. There is also a record of the current judgement regarding your child's most likely final outcome.

#### **Attitude to Learning**

Excellent – Always tries their best in class & cooperates well with peers

Good – Usually tries their best in class & behaves well

Need for improvement – Sometimes needs to be reminded to work harder in class and/or cooperate

Unsatisfactory – Regularly has to be reprimanded for insufficient effort in class and/or behaviour issues.

#### **Homework**

Excellent – Outstanding effort and completed on time

Good – Good effort and completed on time

Satisfactory – Satisfactory effort and completed on time

Unsatisfactory – Late, poor quality or incomplete work and/or not given in.

Please note that the lowest comments for attitude to learning and homework will show as a 'red' comment on the report and indicate a cause for concern that should be fully discussed with your child. A 'green' comment indicates excellent performance and is worthy of recognition.

We would also like to invite you to the next Year 11 Parent/Carer meeting which will be held in school between 4.00 and 7.00pm on Monday 18th December 2023. We will be using our online appointment booking system to make appointments. This allows you to choose your own appointment times with teachers and you will receive an automated email confirming your appointments.

Please be aware that appointments with staff who teach more than one class may not be possible for all students, in which case staff can be contacted via e-mail or telephone at school.

Please note that appointments should be made with subject staff and the school SENDCo, Mr Radbourne, only. Should you wish to discuss pastoral issues with your son/daughter's Form Tutor then please contact them directly by telephone or e-mail to arrange a separate meeting.



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Appointments can be made from 7pm on Friday 8th December 2023 and will close on Friday 15th December 2023 at 9.00am. Should you wish to make any changes after this time, please contact the School Reception.
