Following on from the announcement made by Government on Wednesday 19th January 2022, I thought it would be beneficial to send updated information that we have received from the Department for Education regarding what is happening in schools.

FACE COVERINGS IN CLASSROOMS

As mentioned in the ParentMail that was sent late on Wednesday, face coverings are no longer required to be worn in classrooms from Thursday 20th January 2022. However, if pupils or staff wish to carry on wearing face coverings, they are very welcome to do so.

FACE COVERINGS IN COMMUNAL AREAS

Face coverings are to continue to be worn in communal areas and when walking to and from lessons until next Thursday, 27th January 2022. After this date, face coverings do not need to be worn in school. However, if pupils and staff wish to continue wearing face coverings in these areas after this date, they are very welcome to do so.

With regulations currently changing apace, we will endeavour to keep you informed as and when we receive notification from the Department for Education.
