**Year 10 trip to the University of Oxford, 11<sup>th</sup> June 2024**

I would like to offer an exciting opportunity for your child to partake in a visit to Lady Margaret Hall at the University of Oxford. The purpose of this visit is to show students first-hand what it could be like to live and study at an esteemed higher education institution in the future.

During the day, students will experience a welcome talk, a tour of Lady Margaret Hall, and a further session which could include visiting a subject building, a museum, or experiencing an academic taster session. Students will also benefit from a Q&A with Student Ambassadors who will share their own experiences of applying to and studying at the University of Oxford.

The visit is a valuable source of information about higher education opportunities, and it is expected that students will both learn a great deal and be inspired by the experience.

The trip will take place at Lady Margaret Hall, University of Oxford, on **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2024**. We will leave school at **9.00am and return to school at 5.00pm**. In the afternoon, pupils will have some free time to explore Oxford so they may wish to bring a small amount of spending money or a payment card.

Students are not required to wear school uniform.
