Trip to Cirencester Bingham Library - Monday 18th March 2024

We have an exciting opportunity for your child to participate in an author workshop with Chris Vick at the Cirencester Bingham Library. "Chris Vick, the author of *The Last Whale, Kook, Storms*, and Carnegie shortlisted *Girl. Boy. Sea*, will be facilitating an hour-long interactive talk/workshop about the creative writing process. The workshop will focus on what stories are, where they come from, how to generate ideas and how to put those ideas into a complete story - the theme will be 'Putting Nature on the Page'. The session will help young people create, write and develop their stories, regardless of perceived ability or skill."

The trip will take place on Monday 18th March 2024. We will leave school at 10:30am and return to school by 12:30pm in time for students to enjoy their lunches at school. We will be transporting the students by coach. Students are required to wear school uniform.

I am pleased to confirm that there is no charge for this trip, as the workshop has been gifted from the Cirencester Bingham Library and Gloucestershire Libraries.
