- 1. Summarise Miller's preface to the play (p. 1–5) and show how the action of the play portrays this.
- 2. "Your justice would freeze beer." Consider the characters of Elizabeth and Proctor and/or their relationship in the light of this statement.
- 3. "The play is a study of human motivation." Consider how various characters exploit the situation in Salem.
- 4. "The play is a study of power and manipulation." Select any two or three characters and show how they illustrate the abuse of power.
- 5. According to Miller's play, what are the causes of prejudice?
- 6. What is the significance of the title: *The Crucible*
- 7. "I have given you my soul; leave me my name!" Do you consider John Proctor to be heroic?
- 8. "John Proctor is the tragic hero of *The Crucible*". How far would you agree with this statement
- 9. Discuss the change or lack of change undergone by the main characters.
- 10. Consider the relationship between John Proctor and Abigail Williams and how Arthur Miller presents it to an audience.
