



SCHOOL UNIFORM BURSARY FOR NEW PUPILS

Cirencester Kingshill School attracts Pupil Premium funding for the following children who are currently, or at any time in the past six years, have been:

- Eligible for Free School Meals. Pupils recorded in the January 2020 school census who are known to have been eligible for FSM since May 2015, as well as those first known to be eligible at January 2020.

Or where pupils have been:

- Recorded in the January 2020 school census or alternative provision census, who were looked after by an English or Welsh local authority immediately before being adopted, or who left local authority care on a special guardianship order or child arrangements order (previously known as a residence order).

For the academic year 1st September 2021 to 31st August 2022 we are delighted that we will be able to offer a one-off 40% bursary to families, where their child/children attract the Pupil Premium funding, when they join the school. This bursary will be against a **maximum** purchase of the following uniform per child:

- 1 tie
- 1 blazer
- 2 school jumpers (or 2 cardigans if girls prefer)
- 2 polo shirts (Summer term)
- 1 PE polo shirt
- 1 PE skort / or shorts
- 1 rugby shirt or 1 mid-layer (compulsory for female pupils only)
- 1 calculator, purchased via the School

To qualify for the 40% bursary you will need to contact the Finance Office in writing, enclosing the receipt, confirming the purchase of the school uniform. To enable us to process the claim, all receipts must show that the order was placed and received by the claimant. Please note that all claims must be received within 3 months of the purchase date.
