### Week 1 (w/c Monday 19<sup>th</sup> April): (Game Music: The Legend of Zelda)

**Starter:** Write down as many examples as you can think of of music in games, television, film and apps. Which do you personally hear most often? What is the purpose of the music?

**Main task:** Using the 'Music in the Media' PowerPoint, complete pages 1-5 of the 'Music in the Media' booklet. Start at slide 29 and click the gold triangles to make the text appear. Go through slides 29-26 in order. Slide 36 is your final slide. You don't need to actually compose the theme tune unless you have an instrument available – describing your ideas with words is fine for now!

### Week 2 (w/c Monday 26<sup>th</sup> April): (Game Music: Super Mario)

**Main task:** Using slides 22-27 of the 'Music in the Media' PowerPoint, complete pages 6-7 of the 'Music in the Media' booklet.

Choose a piece of music that you have heard in the media before. This can include on television, in a film, in a game or in an app. Write a page about what you can hear when you listen to it carefully – detailing all of the different elements of music:

*Tempo*

*Texture*

*Articulation*

*Dynamics*

*Timbre & Sonority*

*Duration*

*Pitch*

*Articulation*

*Silence*

**Week 4 (w/c Monday 10<sup>th</sup> May): (Film Music: Lord of the Rings)**

Using slides 4-7 of the PowerPoint, complete pages 22-18 of the booklet (you will need to flip them over using the 'rotate' tool!).

**Week 5 (w/c Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May): (Film Music: Harry Potter)**

Using slides 15-19 of the PowerPoint, complete pages 17-16 of the booklet (you will need to flip them over using the 'rotate' tool!).

**Week 6 (w/c Monday 24<sup>th</sup> May): (Music in the Media)**

Complete the 'Film Music' and 'Game Music' recall tests on pages 12 & 15 of the booklet. You can use the PowerPoint to help you!
